Upon his arrival in Sudan in 2003, Dr. Mukesh Kapila, a veteran of humanitarian crisis and ethnic cleansing in Iraq, Rwanda, Srebrenica, Afghanistan and Sierra Leone, began learning of atrocities in a part of the country few had ever heard of: Darfur. A decade later, the insider who blew the whistle and first brought Darfur to the world's attention shares his story in *Against a Tide of Evil*.

Co-written with Damien Lewis, award-winning author of *Tears of the Desert: A Memoir of Survival in Darfur*, *Slave: My True Story*, *Forbidden Lessons in a Kabul Guesthouse* and other notable titles, Kapila's story reads like a knife-edge international thriller as he risks all to use the powers at his disposal to bring to justice those responsible for the first mass murder of the twenty-first century: the Darfur genocide.

Against a Tide of Evil is a strident and passionate *cri de coeur*. It is the deeply personal account of one man driven to extreme action by the unwillingness of those in power to stop mass murder. The book explores what empowers a man like Dr. Kapila to stand up and be counted, and to act alone in the face of global indifference and venality. Dr Kapila is the winner of the "I Witness Award". *Against a Tide of Evil* was shortlisted for the Crime Writer's Association Best Non-Fiction award in 2013.
